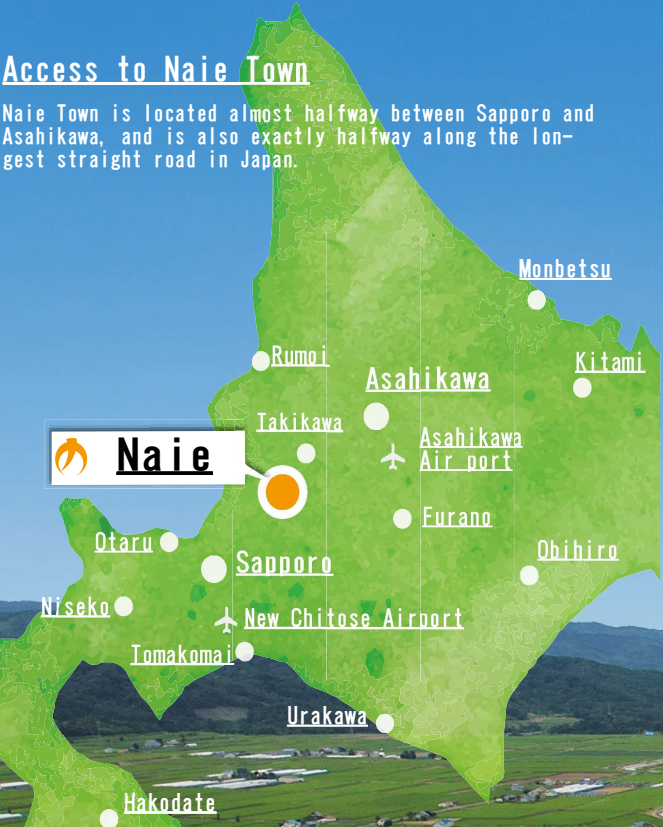


Access to Naie Town

Naie Town is located almost halfway between Sapporo and Asahikawa, and is also exactly halfway along the longest straight road in Japan.

Using Train Excluding connection time

- ★ From Sapporo Station (transfer at Iwamizawa Station).....56minutes
- ★ From Asahikawa Station (transfer at Takikawa Station).....53minutes
- ★ From New Chitose Airport transfer at Sapporo Station or Iwamizawa Station).....1hour 54 minutes
- ★ From Asahikawa Airport (take a bus from the airport to Asahikawa Station, then take the JRtrain from Asahikawa Station).....1hour59minutes

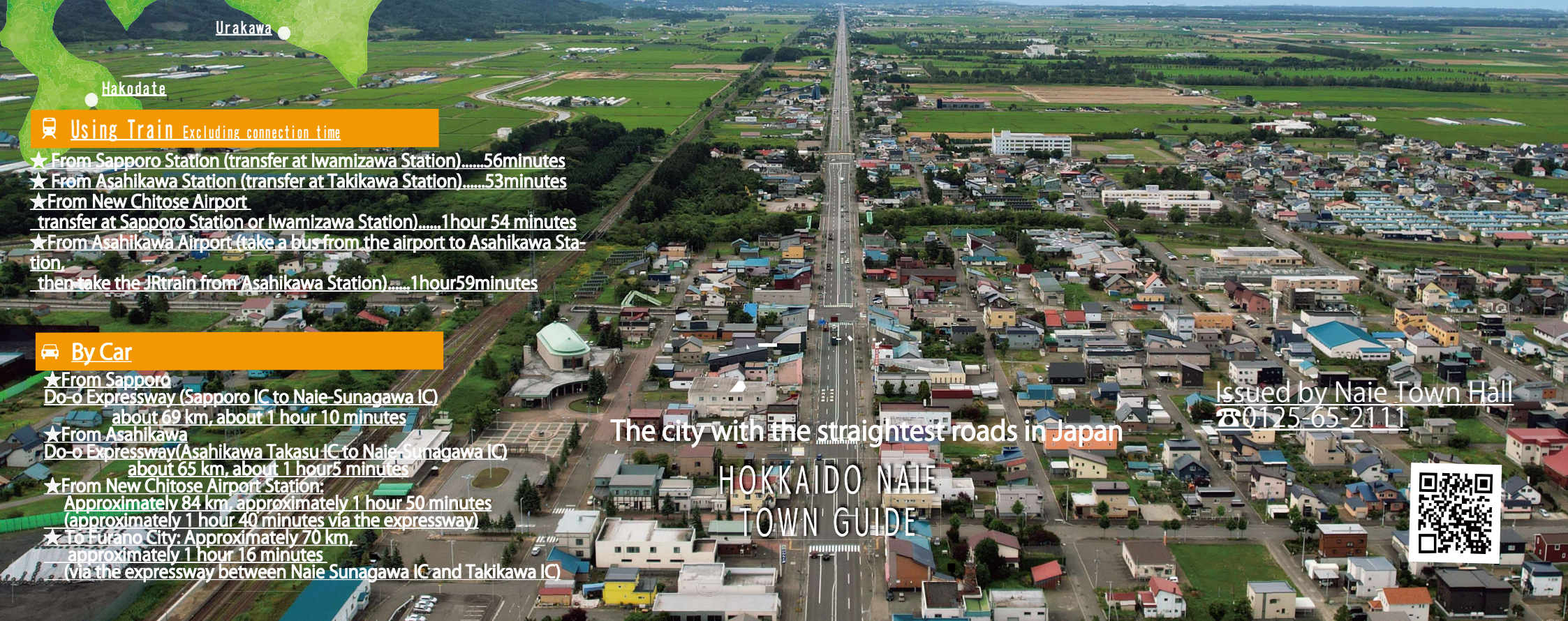
By Car

- ★ From Sapporo Do-o Expressway (Sapporo IC to Naie-Sunagawa IC) about 69 km, about 1 hour 10 minutes
- ★ From Asahikawa Do-o Expressway (Asahikawa Takasu IC to Naie-Sunagawa IC) about 65 km, about 1 hour 5 minutes
- ★ From New Chitose Airport Station: Approximately 84 km, approximately 1 hour 50 minutes (approximately 1 hour 40 minutes via the expressway)
- ★ To Furano City: Approximately 70 km, approximately 1 hour 16 minutes (via the expressway between Naie Sunagawa IC and Takikawa IC)

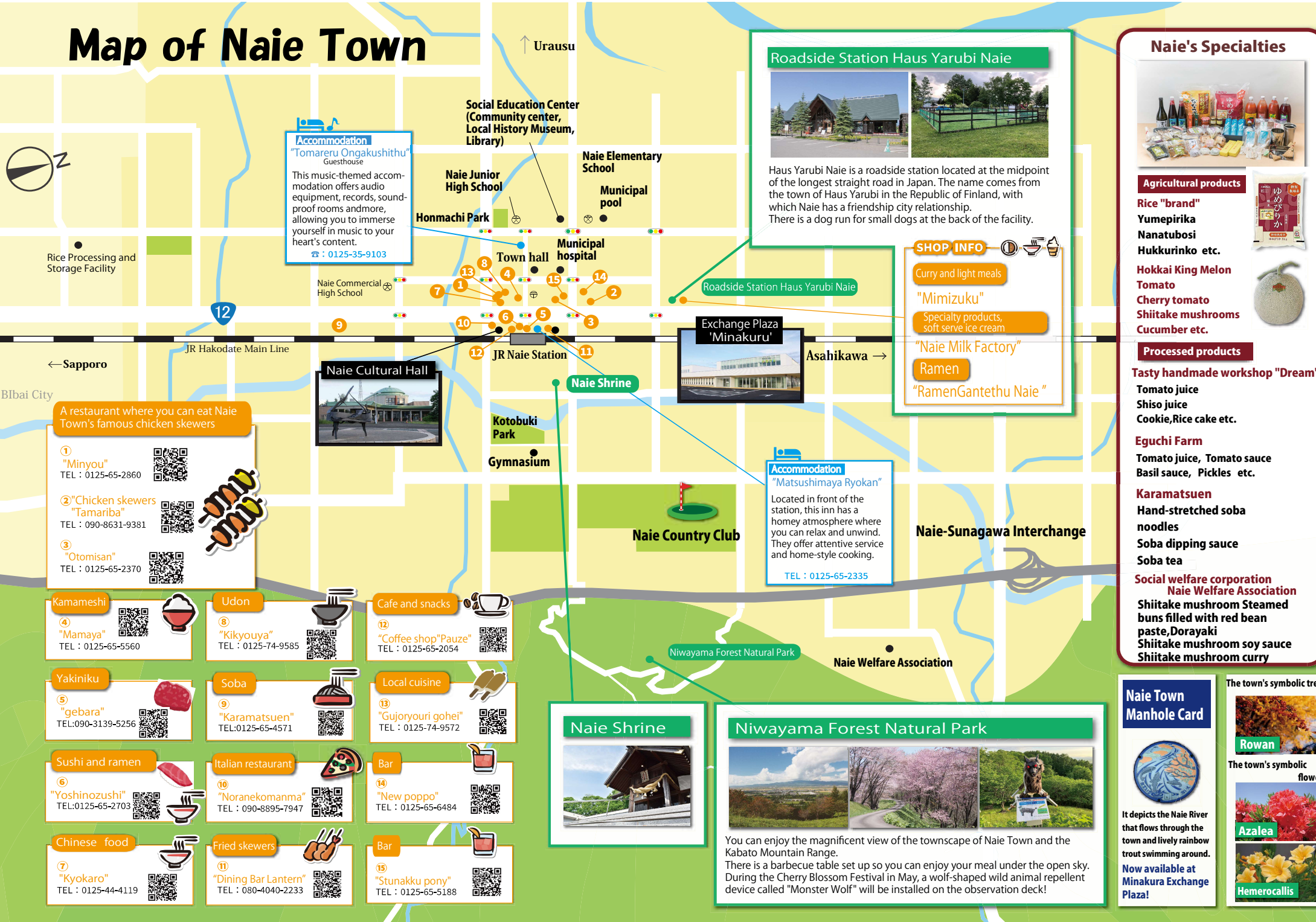
